



## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**FRENCH: Grades 1-4:** Jean Girard from Empire Oaks wants to share her 2<sup>nd</sup> language. Students will use songs games and crafts as well as interaction to learn about food, body parts, weather and more about the calendar. French is a romance language and the basis for many of our English words especially in cooking. New material will be offered and newcomers are welcome.

**LEGOS CLUB: Grades 3 - 5:** Come be creative! Use your imagination! Julaine Dugan will supply the theme for the first class. Students can make their own free form project to fit the theme. Themes for the remaining classes will be chosen by a student vote. Legos will be provided but feel free to bring your own in a plastic bag labeled with your name. Toward the end of the session class will “morph” into a Mr. & Mrs. Potato Club

**DRAWING: Grades 1-6:** Art Wise provides directed drawing instruction in a way that everyone is guaranteed success using a new curriculum every week. This class will help students with skills they can use in school everyday: focus, self-discipline, problem solving, visualization, paying attention to detail and development of motor skills. All supplies are provided. Most of all...Learning to draw is FUN!

**SEASONAL CRAFTS: Grades 1-3:** Create extra ordinary objects from ordinary things! Mary Kelly’s class will make some very cool things. Projects include cornhusk sunflowers, harvest angels, bird feeder, flower pots, a tin man yard ornaments, and wind twirls.

**HIP-HOP: Grades: 1 - 6:** Kristen Meyer, formerly an instructor at El Dorado Dance Academy and a member of their Dance Company, is here to teach the best of urban dance. Hip –Hop is the latest cultural trend on the dance scene and offers exposure to street, funk, lock’n’pop and break as a part of this class. Wear loose comfortable clothing. On the last day of class, students will perform for their parents and friends.

**GAMES: Grades 2-4:** Challenge your minds – learn strategies! And have a lot of fun! This class will introduce Chess, Chinese Checkers, Strategies to play them and new Puzzles Games with Mr. B J Jonnalagadda, an Empire Oaks parent to help with the mental challenges!
